# Status of draft Dehcho Land Use Plan


- Draft Interim Dehcho Land Use Plan submitted to Dehcho Process Main Table on June 26, 2016
- Internal Review being conducted by Parties to Main Table:
  - **Dehcho First Nations** holding information sessions with Dehcho members.
    - Completed to date --- Katlodeeche First Nation, West Point First Nation, Deh Gah Gotie First Nation, Fort Providence Metis Nation, Ka'agee Tu First Nation, Jean Marie River First Nation, Pehdzeh Ki First Nation
    - Still to schedule Nahanni Butte Band, Liidlii Kue First Nation, Fort Simpson Metis Nation, Sambaa K'e Dene Band
  - GNWT almost complete
  - Canada almost complete



# Questions For DFN Internal Review of Draft Plan

- ➤ Does the zoning around communities support their objectives for:
  - providing job opportunities
  - protecting important harvesting and cultural sites
  - protecting candidate protected area sites
- ➤ Was the plan developed in accordance with direction in the *Dehcho First Nation Interim Measures Agreement*?
- ➤ Does the Plan support guidance provided by the elders?

# **Outstanding Issues**

- Dehcho Land Use Plan Committee members worked very well together to resolve many issues when revising draft Interim Plan
- Four issues were referred to the Dehcho Process Main Table to provide direction (as per the 2007 DLUPC Terms of Reference):
  - Ability of Interim Plan to determine location of pipelines.
  - Is direction under the DFN Interim Measures Agreement and the Draft Interim Plan harmonized?
  - Finalizing zoning once process to establish the Edehzhie National Wildlife Area is completed.
  - Should there be conditions for pipelines that cross Conservation Zones and Candidate Protected Area Zones?


