Vhat will a Dehcho Land Use Plan do?

- Foundation of plan remains the same (knowledge of elders, hunters and trappers) -- Nahe Nahodhe
- Plan supports the most important Dene law – Respect for Creation -Mother Earth –
- Support interests of Dehcho communities for where and how land should be used or protected
- Plan manages 5 types of land uses tourism, commercial timber development, mining, agriculture and oil/gas






What will a Dehcho Land Use Plan Do?

7

- Balances lands for conservation and development (48% of land protected)
- Provide certainty for land users on where land use activities may be permitted by regulatory boards
- Provide method for assessing cumulative effects and proposes thresholds based on amount of land disturbed
- Provide guidance on how certain land use activities should be conducted to minimize disturbance to land
- Works with regulatory system



Next Steps - For Plan Approval



Summer 2013
Canada to appoint new member
Committee to provide draft interim plan to the Dehcho Main Table
Dehcho First Nations, Canada and GNWT to do an internal review and provide direction on several issues
This will take about six months
Committee will then revise draft interim plan based on direction from Dehcho Main Table
Committee will provide revised draft interim plan to Dehcho First Nations, Canada and GNWT for approval
