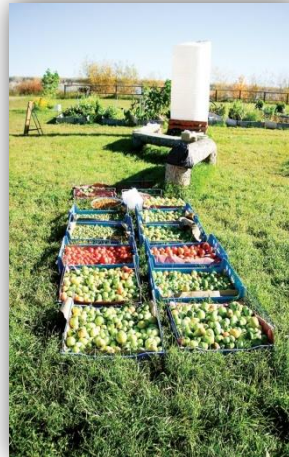

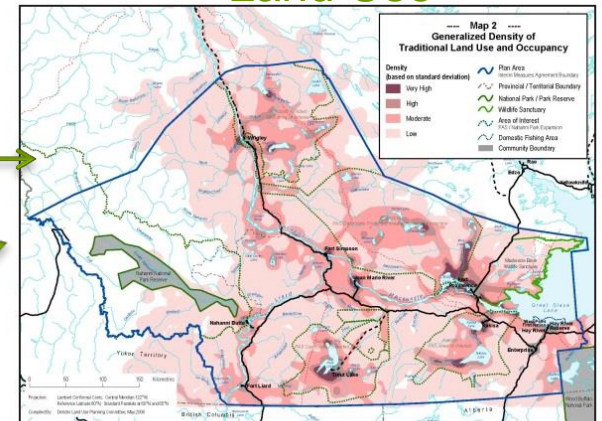

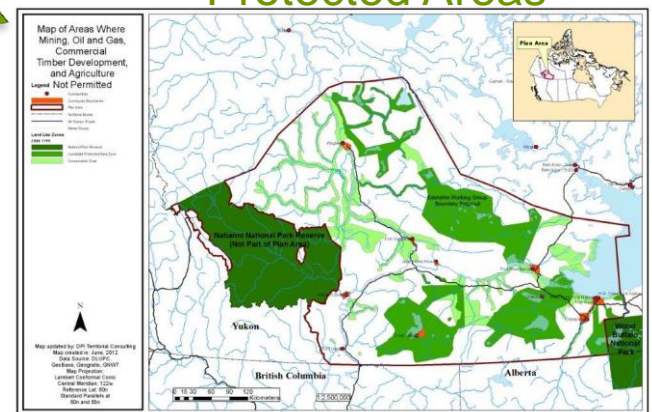
# What has been accomplished?

- Lands near communities have been protected
- Works with regulatory system
- Traditional land use not subject to plan
- Foundation of plan remains the same (knowledge of elders, hunters and trappers) -- **Nahe Nahodhe**
- Proposed balance of lands - 48% of land protected and 51% potentially open for development
- Plan manages 5 types of land uses – **tourism, mining, agriculture, commercial timber development, and oil/gas**

Map of Traditional Land Use

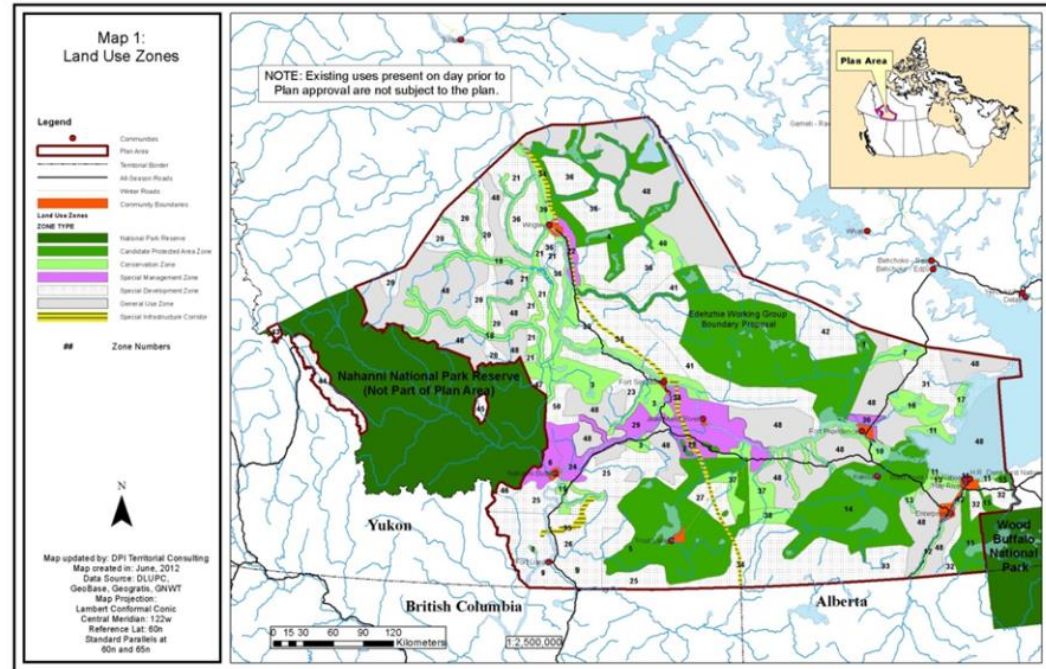


Map of Proposed Protected Areas

- August – DLUPC to review draft interim plan
- September - DLUPC to complete Memo on a few outstanding issues which require direction from Dehcho Process Main Table as per the DLUPC 2007 Terms of Reference
