 Lands near communities have been protected


Works with regulatory system

 Traditional land use not subject to plan


Foundation of plan remains the same (knowledge of elders, hunters and trappers) -- Nahe Nahodhe

 Proposed balance of lands - 48% of land protected and 51% potentially open for development

 Plan manages 5 types of land uses – tourism, mining, agriculture, commercial timber development, and oil/gas Map of Traditional Land Use




Map of Proposed Protected Areas
