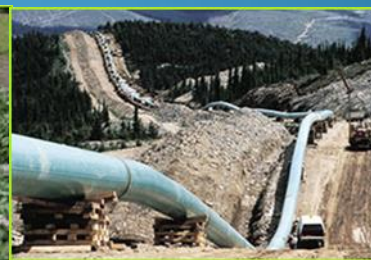

"Most progressive land use plan in Canada"

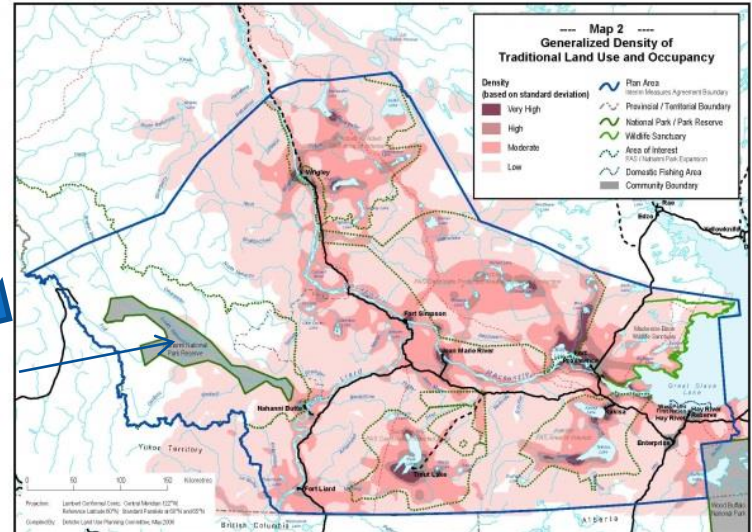

What has been accomplished?

- Traditional land use not subject to plan

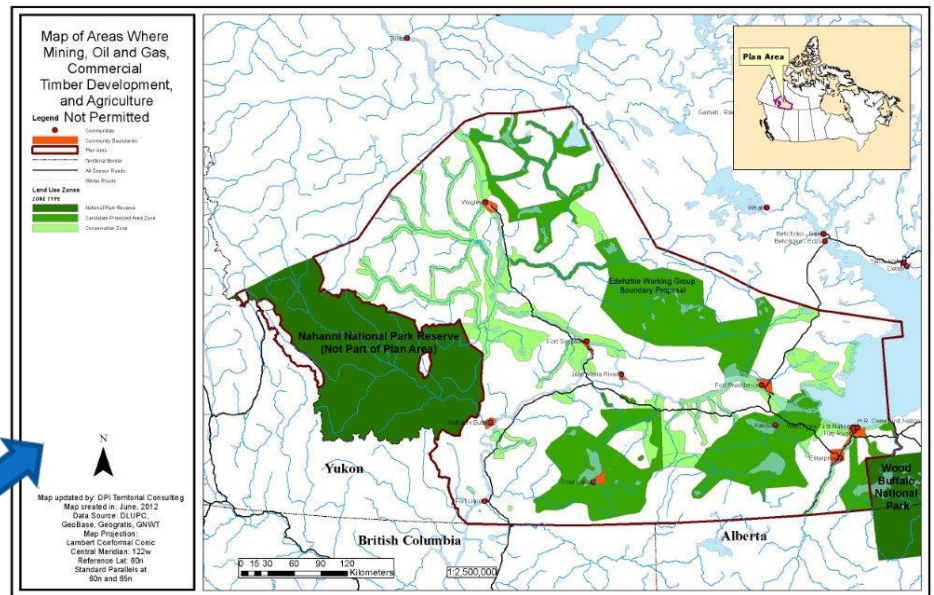
Map of Traditional Land Use



- Foundation of plan remains the same (knowledge of elders, hunters and trappers) -- **Nahe Nahodhe**

- Lands near communities are protected

Map of Proposed Protected Areas



What has been accomplished?

- Works with regulatory system
- Proposed balance of lands - 49% of land protected (when including Nahanni National Park Reserve) and 51% open for development
- Plan manages 5 types of land uses– *tourism, commercial timber development, agriculture, mining and oil/gas*

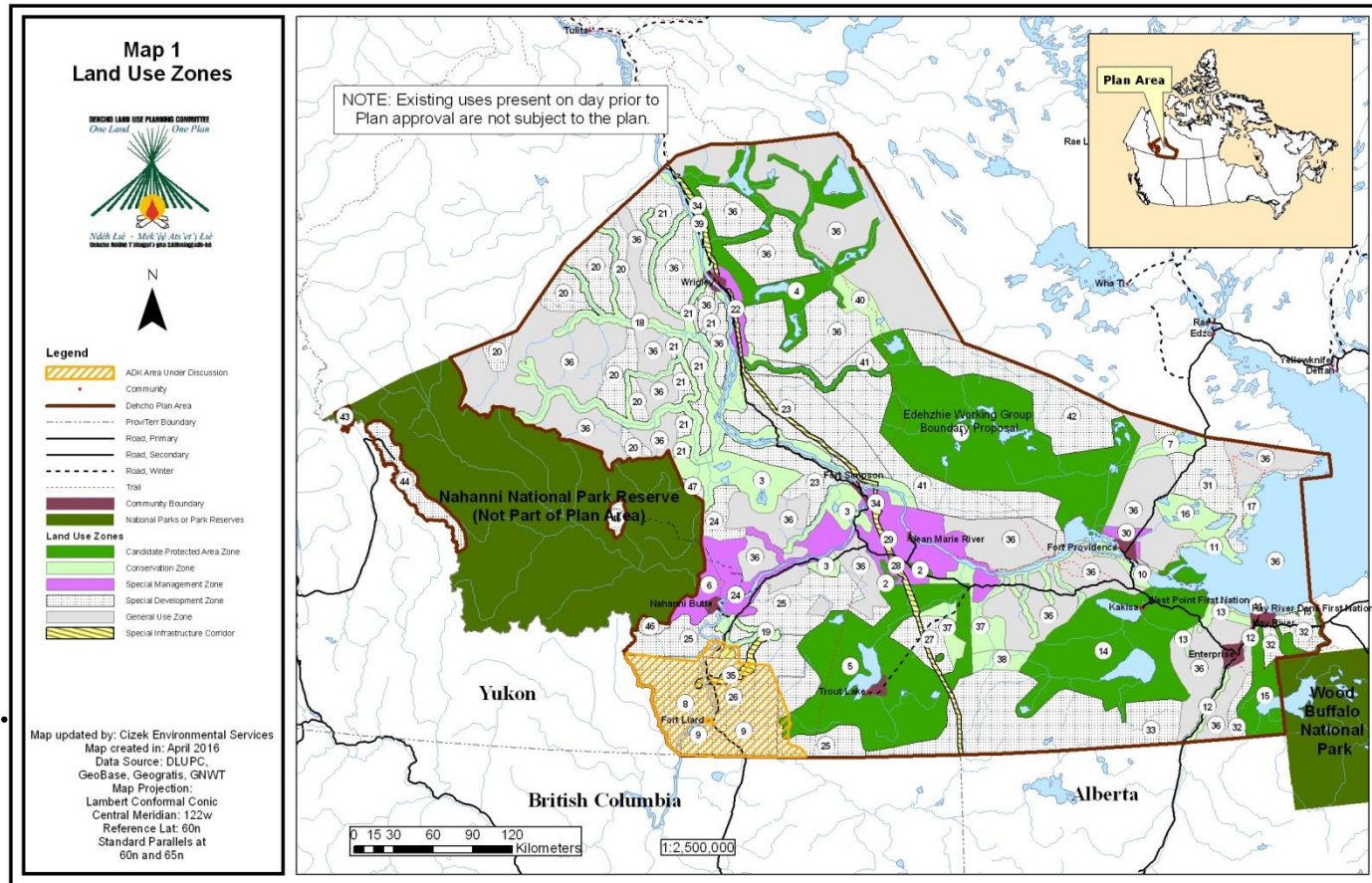
