

What has been accomplished?

- Traditional land use not subject to plan
- Foundation of plan remains the same (knowledge of elders, hunters and trappers) - Nahe Nahodhe
- Lands near communities are protected

What has been accomplished?

- Works with regulatory system
- Proposed balance of lands 49% of land protected (when including Nahanni National Park Reserve) and 51% open for development



 Plan manages 5 types of land uses- tourism, commercial timber development, agriculture, mining and oil/gas


